This company is owned by Andre Smith, who has been OCS Worldwide's agent in Namibia for a number of years. There will also be continuity of service as one of our staff members has joined ACT where he will be responsible for our Express freight.


ECONOMY

Our Economy freight will continue to be dispatched to Windhoek four days a week from Johannesburg and Cape Town via our new Economy partner Truckair. Freight in Windhoek and the rest of Namibia will be delivered by Truckair's sister company, Cross Country Carriers (CCC) who are Windhoek based.

Again, continuity of service is assured as most of our Namibian staff has moved across to CCC, where they will continue to be linked to our networks, data links and email systems. The ability to do Confirmation of Deliveries and image Proof of Deliveries/Customs documents will remain uninterrupted. The Economy freight operation can still be reached on the existing Namibian telephone and fax numbers, and email addresses.
